The leaving date column is the earliest date a child of that age may leave school and the date after which he/she is not of compulsory/mandatory school age.

Children over this age can/and do return to school for further education but they would not be considered 'children' under Child Employment and Child Entertainment (performance) legislation. They would not be required to be registered for employment for part-time jobs under the permit system nor licensed for performances, such as modelling, theatre, commercials, films, TV, sound recordings, sport and so forth with their Local Authority.
